The Wallace Collection

The Wallace Collection is a national museum displayed in Hertford House, a historic London town house. In 25 galleries are to be found unsurpassed displays of French 18th century painting, furniture and porcelain with superb Old Master paintings and a world class armoury. These were collected in the 18th century and 19th century by the first four Marquesses of Hertford and Sir Richard Wallace, the son of the 4th Marquess. It was bequeathed to the British nation by Sir Richard's widow Lady Wallace in 1897.

After the visit the rest of the time is at leisure.
